

### Advice for the Last Semester of College:

College is a great time and place to work on developing soft skills. These types of skills are transferable and beneficial to you in your professional career. Before starting your career, learn how to effectively manage your time, use critical thinking to solve problems, and develop a strong work ethic. Learning these skills before entering the workforce is a terrific way to make a seamless transition into your career. Most importantly, make sure you enjoy your last semester in college!

### **Post-Graduation Advice:**
